



Suffolk Center for Cultural Arts Student Scholarship

The Suffolk Center for Cultural Arts Student Scholarship will be available to students who live in and attend school in Suffolk, either public, private or home school. To be eligible for an educational scholarship for classes, lessons and/or workshops offered at the Suffolk Center for Cultural Arts (SCCA), students must be entering kindergarten through twelfth grade in the 2011-2012 school year.

A selection committee of SCCA board members will choose the recipients, and all decisions will be final. The recipients will receive written confirmation of the scholarship award in January for classes beginning January 23rd. The scholarship funds will be paid directly to the SCCA for the awarded class, lessons or workshop. Any unused funds will revert to the Student Scholarship Fund.

Eligible artistic areas which the applicants may choose to pursue include, but are not limited to, visual and performing arts such as children's chorus, dance, movement, art, theater, music, voice classes or workshops and/or camps. Selection of Recipient:

The primary basis upon which the scholarship recipients will be selected are as follows:

Talent: Student must display a talent and/or desire to excel in the artistic area of choice.

Need: Students must demonstrate that this scholarship is needed to continue or begin studying the artistic area of choice.

Student Achievement: Student must maintain a good school standing.

Application Requirements:

1. Completed application form.
2. Recommendation from his/her teacher, guidance counselor or other knowledgeable person. This recommendation cannot be from an immediate family member.
3. Third through twelfth grade applicants must submit an attached essay stating their goals and desire to pursue the artistic area of choice.

Upon completion of awarded scholarship, recipients will be asked to complete a SCCA evaluation form describing their experience.
